

Club Championship 18 May 2023 GC Kampenhout.

1. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- a) The Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Limited and with Local Rules as approved by the Tournament Committee.
- b) All disputes shall be settled by the Tournament Committee whose decision will be final.
- c) The Tournament Committee reserves the right to fix and/or alter the Tournament Conditions and/or Starting Times.

2. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The Championship is open for all players:

Homeclub Member of Golfclub Kampenhout, holder of a federal card which is valid for the year 2023. Subscription in Gents - Gents Seniors / Juniors (First round) or Ladies - Ladies Seniors + Juniors (First round)

• Categories:

■ Ladies, Blue tees, Max. WHS Hcp 20,4	(no age restrictions)
Men, White tees, Max. WHS Hcp 15,4	(no age restrictions)
■ Senior Ladies, Blue tees, Max. WHS Hcp: 20,4	(Born 1973 or older)
■ Senior Men, White tees, Max. WHS Hcp: 15,4	(Born 1973 or older)
■ Juniors: girls Blue tees, Max. WHS Hcp: 20,4	(Born 2005 or younger)
■ Boys White tees, Max. WHS Hcp: 20,4	(Born 2005 or younger)

• Entry:

Players must enrol via i-golf

Closing Date of Entry: Monday May 15th, 2022 at 23:59 hrs.

Enrol in your specific category. If you enrol for Ladies or Men category you will be automatically also enrolled in the senior or junior category if you are eligible for these categories. If you enrol in Ladies/Men category you need to be prepared to play 2 rounds the same day.

• Maximum number of Entries: 66 (max 45 men and max 21 ladies)

In the event of entries exceeding this number, entry will be decided using WHS Handicaps. (As on May 15, 2023) Unsuccessful entrants will be given the opportunity to compete in the event of withdrawals.

A draw will be made 2 days before the start of the tournament to select the entrants to compete in the competition and to select a list of reserves. The order will be based on the WHS Handicap of the player. In case a player applies for entry after the closing date, he/she will be placed on the reserve list.

- Any competitor whose withdrawal is not notified within 24 hours of the start of the Championship may have future entries rejected.
- Any competitor who is absent from the Championship without notice of withdrawal will be automatically suspended for the next three competitions/qualifying rounds for which the player would be able to enter.

3. CONDITIONS OF PLAY

• Conditions:

The Championship will be played by Single Stroke (no handicap).

Men & Ladies Category will play 2x18 holes on the same day.

Senior Men, Senior Ladies and Juniors will be played over 18 holes. If Senior Men, Senior Ladies or Juniors also play in the Men or Ladies category the first round will count for the score in the Senior or Junior category.

For the Men and Ladies categories a cut will be established as follows:

Men: <u>16 + ties and Max</u>. **Score 89** first round.

Ladies: 12 + ties and Max. Score of 95 first round.

The player with the least number of strokes will be the winner. In case of a tie at the end of the final round a hole-by-hole play-off in stroke play will be played to decide the winner. The holes on which the play-off will be played will be published latest on the morning of the final round.

• Timings:

<u>First round:</u> The First flight will start approximately 7:30h. Lowest WHS hcp will start playing first followed by higher handicaps. Flights will be planned with 3 players in the first round. Players will start on hole 1 and 10.

Ladies will all start from hole 10. Lowest WHS handicap Men will all start from hole 1 (33 lowest handicap) and higher hcp Men players will start at hole 10.

<u>Second round:</u> The First flight will start at 13:30h and will be in flights of 2 players. Players will play in reverse order based on results of the first round from Hole 1. Players with the best results in the first round will be in the last flights. Last flight of the second round should be no later than 15:00h.

<u>Categories with one round:</u> flights will be planned around the categories that play two rounds.

Recordings:

After 9 holes, we will record your scores on the 9th and 18th hole, by taking a picture of scorecard, this will limit the time during your play. Players are obliged to show their scorecard when requested by the organisation during your round.

After 18 holes please record your scores as quick as possible, to be able to prepare the second round.

4. PRIZES AND PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

The winners and runners-up (Ladies, Men, Senior Ladies, Senior Men, Juniors separated) will receive an award from Golfclub Kampenhout.

5. Penalties

All players that do not follow the rules of the competition as described in the general conditions can be penalized in following way:

First infraction: Warning

Second infraction: General penalty, if in between 2 holes it will be on the next hole, if on 18th hole on the same hole, before the competition on hole 1, or before returning the score card.

Third infraction: Disqualification

6. Competition Committee & Rules Officials

For this competition the committee will consist of the Sport Committee.

Final decisions will be with the Captain of GC Kampenhout.

Marshals will help on the course and will report back to the Rules committee.
